Second Annual Jets & Corvettes Event on August 4

TULSA, Okla. – Fast cars and fast planes will be on display at the second annual Jets & Corvettes. This event will take place from 10 a.m. to 1 p.m. on Saturday, August 4 at the Tulsa Air and Space Museum & Planetarium (TASM).

In partnership with the Tulsa Vette Set, this event will feature a car show with about 50 corvettes. The cars will be competing for a “People’s Choice” trophy, with the winner being selected by museum visitors. Anyone is welcome to bring a Corvette of any vintage for display, but only Tulsa Vette Set club members are eligible to win. Regular museum admission is needed for access to the event and a “People’s Choice” voting ballot.

In addition to the corvettes, several jets will be on display with the iconic sports cars, including a Bombardier Challenger 300 and an Aero L-39 Albatros. There will also be food trucks, live music and all the entertaining exhibits and activities that TASM offers.

The Tulsa Vette Set was established in 1971 and is the fourth largest Corvette Club in America, with 345 active members and in continuous operating for more than 45 years.
