POSITIONS AVAILABLE

Greeters Greet visitors and encourage them to sign in with demographic information, which helps grant funding reports.

Docents Give museum tours to groups. Must have thorough knowledge of TASM facility, exhibits, and programs.

Education Team Assist the TASM education department with children's activities (such as stomp rockets or landers), scout programs, and field trips.

Facility Maintenance Help keep the facility clean and presentable as a learning environment for visitors. Includes exhibits, grounds, and aircrafts as needed.

Rovers Share TASM's history, aircraft, and exhibits with visitors in a designated exhibit hall area. Help visitors with hands-on exhibits.

Special Events Assist with TASM events and promote the museum's mission throughout the year.
